It was useful to discuss the A303 and the M4 to south coast study with Mr Barlow and officials for National Highways and Department of Transport today.

I await options for the A350 which is becoming a de facto trunk road and, in particular, the long awaited bypass at Westbury and Yarnbrook.

I remain concerned about the A303. Given that there is vanishing prospect of progress on the Wylde to Mere stretch within a recognisable timeframe, I would be grateful for an assessment of what can be done to mitigate at Chicklade (including a 40mph speed limit) and at Willoughby Hedge (a roundabout or slip road improvement).
