Dear Michael,

I wrote on 28 January 2022 to ask for the application to build an old style waste incinerator in Westbury to be 'called in.'

The planning authority has just, rightly, rejected an application to build a gas fired power station on an adjacent site on the grounds that it would worsen air quality in the Westbury Air Quality Management Area. However, the logic extends to the waste incinerator which the planning authority has approved. It is not difficult to see the inconsistency.

My purpose in writing is to add to the strong case already made against the incinerator application and to urge you again to call it in. I attach a link to the relevant press report:
